The Scholarships will be awarded to Old Girls commencing their third year of an engineering, science-related or law degree or the first year of a postgraduate law degree.

- Please provide a personal statement of no more than 800 words outlining
  - contribution to university life (including any leadership roles);
  - community involvement;
  - your love of engineering, science or law.
- Please provide a copy of your university academic record.
