2020 Training Fees

2019 was an exciting and successful year for the club and we now look to carry that momentum into the new year. In order to do so, we must recognise that the expenses of maintaining the excellent facilities and the engine room of our success – our coaches, increases each year. Consequently, there is a modest increase in the Monthly Training Fees for 2020 of \$2.50 that became effective on 1 January 2020.

Monthly Squad Training Fees

Junior	\$127.50
Intermediate	\$147.50
State	\$157.50
National	\$157.50

We will continue to cater for swimmers who are only able to train on a **casual** basis. The fee per training session will increase to \$20 and will be effective as of 1 February 2020.

PLEASE NOTE: Both monthly and casual charges will now be processed in the week following the billing period, ie January 2020 training fees will be processed in the first week of February.

Membership

To assist in creating an even better sense of belonging to our club and to provide funds for the committee to use for the benefit of members, we will be asking all swimmers to take up membership through the Swimming WA website. When paying your membership, you support both North Coast Swim Club and the stewards of the sport in WA – Swimming WA, with the funds being divided between the two entities. All swimmers in our Intermediate, State and National squads will have until the start of the short course season to take up either a General Membership (\$195) or a Full Membership (\$261). We have extended the timeframe until the start of the short course season to allow members to pay the pro-rata fee that SWA usually makes available at this time. It will not be mandatory for swimmers in our Junior Squad to take up a membership, though we would appreciate them doing so.
