Scholarship Applications for 2022 Entry

Thank you for expressing an interest in St Mary's Anglican Girls' School. We have a proud tradition of providing a challenging, diverse and enjoyable education, which incorporates the pursuit of excellence and a love of learning in a beautiful, spacious environment.

I am pleased to announce the scholarship exam program for Year 7 to Year 11 entry in 2022.

St Mary's Anglican Girls' School, Presbyterian Ladies' College and Penrhos College, three of Western Australia's independent girls' schools of distinction, are collaborating to refine processes for applicants interested in our schools for 2022 scholarships.

Academic Assessment Services has been engaged to administer the scholarship exam in 2021 for applicant placement in 2022. The exam for the scholarships being offered will take place on the same day. Current and new students may apply for all scholarships. Please check the website for eligibility criteria.

It is important for parents to understand that scholarship applicants will be able to nominate three school preferences and applicants will sit the scholarship at the school nominated as their first preference. This is critical to the program's overall success: that is, to increase the likelihood of being offered a place at St Mary's, parents must list us as their first preference school and applicants will sit the exam on our campus. Alternative exam arrangements may be organised with Academic Assessment Services for families located 400km or more away from St Mary's.

The cost to sit the scholarship exam for 2022 is set at \$100 regardless of the number of scholarships applied for at a specific school. If you would like to be considered by more than one school in our co-operative, you can nominate a second and third preference, for which there is an additional charge of \$50 per school.

Registration closes on Friday 19 February 2021. Applicants will sit the exam on Friday 26 February 2021 at the school selected as their first preference (applicants must arrive by 8.20 am).

Once the exam is complete, no contact of any form by co-operative schools will be entered into with applicants prior to Wednesday 17 March 2021. Only shortlisted applicants will be contacted after results have been provided to the school. Interviews with prospective scholarship recipients will commence on Monday 22 March and continue through until Thursday 1 April 2021.

We respectfully request that families not contact St Mary's or any other school outside of this specified timeframe. Further, it is important to note that each school budgets and plans their scholarship offerings very carefully and that requests for higher scholarship amounts will not be considered.

Applicants who have been offered a scholarship must respond in writing to me no later than noon on Monday 19 April 2021. Second round offers may commence on Tuesday 20 April 2021.

St Mary's does not provide scholarship exam results to applicants.
