



Academic Scholarship Information 2022

Year 7

- **Academic Scholarships** are offered for part remission of tuition for each of the final six years of secondary schooling. The scholarships are open to all students commencing Year 7 in 2022.
- The **PB Arney Scholarship** is awarded to the student who achieves the highest mark based on results in the scholarship exam and school reports while in Year 6.
- The **Marlene Carter Old Girls' Association Scholarship** offers part remission of tuition and is open to daughters and granddaughters of financial Life Members of the Old Girls' Association who will be students in Year 7 in 2022. This scholarship is for Year 7 only.

Year 8

- **Academic Scholarships** are offered for part remission of tuition for each of the remaining five years of secondary schooling. The scholarships are open to all students commencing Year 8 in 2022.
- The **Hon. I Viner AO QC Scholarship** is awarded to the student who achieves the highest mark based on results in the scholarship exam and school reports while in Year 7.
- The **Marlene Carter Old Girls' Association Scholarship** offers part remission of tuition and is open to daughters and granddaughters of financial Life Members of the Old Girls' Association who will be students in Year 8 in 2022. This scholarship is for Year 8 only.

Year 9

- **Academic Scholarships** are offered for part remission of tuition for each of the final four years of secondary schooling. The scholarships are open to all students commencing Year 9 in 2022.
- The **Mr RG Gibson Scholarship** is awarded to the student who achieves the highest mark based on results in the scholarship exam and school reports while in Year 8.

Year 10

- **Academic Scholarships** are offered for part remission of tuition for each of the final three years of secondary schooling. The scholarships are open to all students commencing Year 10 in 2022.

Year 11

- **Academic Scholarships** are offered for part remission of tuition for each of the final two years of secondary schooling. The scholarships are open to all students commencing Year 11 in 2022.
- The **Ethel Beaton Old Girls' Association Scholarship** offers part remission of tuition and is open to daughters and granddaughters of financial Life Members of the Old Girls' Association who will be students in Year 11 in 2022. The scholarship is for both Year 11 and Year 12.



Scholarship Requirements

In order to qualify for these scholarships, applicants are required to:

- complete the online scholarship registration at www.stmarys.wa.edu.au/scholarships **by Friday 19 February 2021**;
- sit the **scholarship exam** held at St Mary's on **Friday 26 February 2021**; and
- if shortlisted, attend an **interview** with the Principal in **March/April 2021**.

If your daughter is not currently enrolled at St Mary's, the following documents must be **uploaded** to the registration website **on or before Friday 19 February 2021**:

- 2020 school reports;
- most recent NAPLAN results; and
- photo ID.
