

The Jane Gillon Arts Award is awarded to a Year 11 student who intends to continue studying her chosen Arts subject in Year 12.

About the Award

During 2007, the Old Girls' Association (OGA) elected to broaden the focus of the scholarships it offered and in doing so, introduced the Jane Gillon Arts Award.

The award is named to honour the contribution of Jane Gillon (Fisher '70) to the St Mary's Anglican Girls' School Old Girls' Association. Mrs Gillon was a member of the OGA Committee between 1987 and 2015. She was President for eight years between 1999-2007 and again in 2009.

The Jane Gillon Arts Award is awarded to a Year 11 student who intends to continue studying her chosen Arts subject in Year 12. The award will be presented when a suitable candidate has been identified and, therefore, may not be awarded each year. It will provide the opportunity for an outstanding student of Dance Studies, Design Fundamentals, Drama, Materials, Design and Technology, Media Production and Analysis, Music or Visual Arts, to receive financial assistance up to \$750 towards her studies, during Year 12.

The Jane Gillon Arts Award, unlike other OGA scholarships, is available to all Year 11 students who are studying any of the above subjects, not just to daughters or granddaughters of Old Girls.

Selection Criteria

It is essential that candidates have demonstrated excellence and high achievement in their chosen field over the past eighteen months. In addition, being a fine role model and having made a contribution to St Mary's and/or the wider community in their chosen field, will be important.

Applications should be in writing and include the following:

- 1. Covering letter addressing
 - Reasons for your interest in the chosen field.
 - Involvement and experience in the field.
 - Future goals in the field.
 - If successful, how the award will be used during Year 12.
 - Reasons for being a worthy recipient of the award.
- 2. Resumé detailing your awards and achievements.
- 3. The names of two referees, one of whom will be the Head of Department.
- 4. A portfolio (if relevant).
- 5. Clearly labelled Audio-visual support in the form of DVD, video, photograph, CD etc. Any media formats must be saved in a generic format that can be opened on a Windows or Apple-based device.
- 6. Please ensure your that submission is clearly labelled, including any USB drives.

Please complete the application form on the following page and return it with the supporting material.

Applicants will be invited to attend an interview early in Term 1, 2023.

The award winner will be invited to attend an OGA meeting to discuss their award and chosen field.
