

The Lynne Thomson Overseas Study Scholarship supports Old Girls who are pursuing further education at an overseas university.

The Lynne Thomson Overseas Study Scholarship was established in 2018 by the St Mary's Anglican Girls' School Foundation, in recognition of Mrs Thomson's contribution to the School during her 21 years as Principal. It was awarded for the first time in 2019.

Mrs Thomson became St Mary's ninth Principal in 1997, retiring in 2018. Lynne completed a BA (Hons) in History and a Diploma of Education at UWA, followed by a Master of Education at Harvard University. During her time at St Mary's, Lynne has served on many committees and councils including President of the Association of Independent Girls' Schools of WA and Anglican Schools Australia, State Representative on the Alliance of Girls' Schools Australia Committee and Board member of St George's College and Curtin University. She is a member of the WA Anglican Schools' Council.

Mrs Thomson believes that education is the key to a lively and enlightened mind and a happy and challenging life. Her time at

Harvard was life-changing. "Attending a leading university provided me with a whole new world of academic and cultural experiences and friends around the globe".



Eligibility

The Lynne Thomson Overseas Study Scholarship is open to Old Girls, who graduated from St Mary's in Year 12, and who have accepted enrolment into an undergraduate or postgraduate degree course at a highly ranked overseas university, such as an Oxbridge or Ivy League institution.

This scholarship is not available for students embarking on an exchange programme.

Selection Criteria

- Please complete the scholarship application form.
- Please provide a personal statement of no more than 600 words addressing
 - why you have chosen to pursue this course and why you have chosen this university;
 - · your study and career aspirations; and
 - · your contribution to school and university life.
- Please also provide
 - a copy of your most recent academic record eg Year 12 grades, ATAR score or university academic record. High academic achievement is an important criteria for this award.
 - the name and telephone number of a referee from St Mary's or, if you are at university, a referee from your university.

Additional Information

- Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview with members of School Executive.
- The total amount awarded each year will not exceed \$1,500.
- In each year, if there is more than one worthy applicant, the judges may choose to make more than one award. Should there be no worthy applicants, there will be no award.
