The Helen Hyslop (Judge '50, Head Girl) was a passionate artist. In 2009, she generously established an award to support Old Girls in the Arts industry.

Eligibility

This award recognises Old Girls who are either:

- Commencing their second or third year of a Fine Arts, Arts* or Performing Arts** University degree, or
- Currently practising a professional career within the Fine Arts, Arts or Performing Arts industry
- * The 'Arts', under this award criteria, is defined as: painting, sculpture, drawing, print media, photography, design and textiles, jewellery, ceramics, and Architecture. If you are unsure if your specialty qualifies, please contact the Alumni team.
- ** The 'Performing Arts' under this award criteria is limited to: costume, design, props and scenery.

Award

- Shortlisted candidates will be invited for an interview with members of School Executive.
- The total amount awarded each year will not exceed \$1500.
- In each year, if there is more than one worthy applicant, the judges may choose to make more than one award.
 However, the total funds will not exceed \$1500.
- Should there be no worthy applicants, there will be no award.

Criteria

- Please complete the award application form.
- Please provide a covering letter of no more than 800 words outlining:
 - How this award will help support your endeavor in the Fine Arts / Arts / Performing Arts including any specific projects, exhibitions, or activities that you are currently working on or towards;
 - How you intend to use the funds from the award;
 - Your commitment to and successes in the field of the Arts or Performing Arts so far;
 - Any community involvement, volunteer work, support or collaborations in the Arts / Performing Arts industry that exemplifies your passion and commitment to this industry.
- Copy of your University academic record or a list of your exhibitions, showings, performances or works to date.
